

A Brief History

Bisexual Organizing Project (BOP) grew out of community organizations operating in the Twin Cities in the 1980s and 1990s. In 1999, BOP incorporated as a Minnesota nonprofit and earned IRS 501(c)(3) status. BOP is currently a Gold-level GuideStar Exchange participant.

The BOP board of directors is elected at our annual meeting, which is open to all supporters of BOP. All annual meeting attendees are eligible to stand for election, and all attendees may vote.
